

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PER SE - .08% BAC NOTIFICATION OF FINDINGS AND DECISION & ORDER OF SET ASIDE







The stay of the suspension against your driving privilege has been ended. The suspension resulting from the arrest on October 14, 2016, is hereby set aside.

is hereinafter also known as "Respondent."

The following findings and determinations are the results of your hearing on January 09, 2017.

#### Reasonable Cause:

On or about Friday, October 14, 2016, came into contact with Respondent. Respondent was involved in or owned a vehicle involved in a traffic collision occurring at an undetermined time.

Based on the absence of an established time that Respondent had been driving, Officer Huerta did not have reasonable cause to believe that Respondent was driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol.

#### Lawful Arrest:

Because of the fact that reasonable cause could not be established, it is hereby determined that Respondent was not lawfully arrested for a violation of driving under the influence of alcohol.

As a result of the findings contained herein, the administrative action against Respondent's driving privilege cannot be upheld in this case.

#### Other Findings:

° The testimony of Officer J. Huerta is deemed credible in that the opportunity to perceive the events testified to is reliable, because: He admitted not being able to establish the time of the crash because he never asked the driver about the time he drove the vehicle and never touched the vehicle to see if it was warm. He indicated no witnesses at the scene and was unable to reveal who reported the accident to police dispatch. The facts on the documentary evidence on file did not infer that the accident occurred within three hours of the dispatch call. He admitted the assisting officer did not establish the time of the crash either. As a result the administrative action in this case cannot be upheld.

#### **DETERMINATION OF ISSUES**

- 1) The peace officer had reasonable cause to believe you were driving a motor vehicle in violation of Vehicle Code Section 23140, 23152, or 23153.
- 2) You were placed under lawful arrest.

3) You were not driving a motor vehicle when you had .08% or more by weight of alcohol in your blood.

#### **DECISION**



## ADMINISTRATIVE PER SE - .08% BAC NOTIFICATION OF FINDINGS AND DECISION & ORDER OF SET ASIDE







The stay of the suspension against your driving privilege has been ended. The suspension resulting from the arrest on July 31, 2016, is hereby set aside.

Nathan is hereinafter also known as "Respondent."

The following findings and determinations are the results of your hearing on November 16, 2016.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

#### **Probable Cause:**

On or about Sunday, July 31, 2016 at 12:57 AM, Officer A. Yribe, Badge # 21169, and Officer B. Holguin, Badge # 21149, both of the California Highway Patrol (CHP), East Los Angeles Station, Officer A. Yribe while on patrol on the northbound L-710 Freeway, north of Olympic Blvd, observed Respondent driving a motor vehicle (black Nissan Versa) and over taking the patrol vehicle at a high rate of speed. Officer reported that Respondent's vehicle passed patrol vehicle's location in the Number 1 lane, nearly colliding into the center median. Officer further reported that his partner pace Respondent's vehicle from Whittier Blvd to SR-60 at approximately 60 MPH in a posted 45 MPH, a violation of the California Vehicle Code.

Respondent was present at hearing; however, was represented by Counsel. Counsel in behalf of Respondent provided foundation as to Respondent's Exhibit "A" (MVARS Video) via by Officer's direct testimony. Counsel pointed and used Officer's testimony as to support he contention in that Officer just observed respondent driving 5 seconds, from Olympic Blvd on-ramp to the I-710 of which was when the recording started, through the Third Street off-ramp, and of which at no time was Respondent observed from the Whittier Blvd to the SR-60 Freeway. Officer testified that he once in the freeway the patrol vehicle was in the number 4 lane, then the number 4 lane merged onto the number 3 lane of which was at this point next to Respondent's lane of travel of which at all time was in the number 2 lane and at no time did Respondent went through the number 1 lane and near or towards the center median. As to the 45 MPH posted speed sign of related that he did not recall any posted sign; however, he does believe there are in the area, but on the video he did not see any signs and Respondent passed vehicle that was next to Officer upon entering the freeway and related that Respondent remained the same speed as the traffic in front of Respondent and Officer. Therefore, obviously Officer contradicting his report as to him observing Respondent driving in the number 1 lane, nearly colliding with the center divider wall, related that he did not determined the speed and that his partner bumper pace the vehicle; however, could not recall a posted limit, did not see a posted limit was also incorrect as to from when Respondent was first observed. Therefore, Counsel further contends that based on Officer's truthful testimony as shown in Respondent's Exhibit "A" the Department does not have its case as there in insufficient probable cause for Officer to have initiate a stop and thereby Counsel motion that the case against Respondent's driving privilege be set aside. It is Trier's determination that based on Officer's testimony and Respondent's Exhibit "A," Counsel's motion to set aside is hereby granted.

The evidentiary basis for the finding on the probable cause issue is:

° The testimony of Officer A. Yribe confirms the events.



Objective Symptoms:

Subsequent to making contact with Respondent, Officer Yribe formed the belief that Respondent was intoxicated after having observed the following objective symptoms of intoxication:

° Bloodshot and watery eyes.

Odor of alcoholic beverage.

Officer Yribe also considered the following as contributing factors in forming the belief of intoxication:

- Our Unsatisfactory Field Sobriety Tests.
- ° PAS result indicated intoxication.
- ° An admission of alcohol consumption.

The evidentiary basis for the finding on the objective symptoms of intoxication issue is:

° The Age 21 and Older Officer's Statement (DS367).

° The State of California - Department California Highway Patrol (CHP) DUI Arrest-Investigation Report (CHP202).

#### Reasonable Cause:

Based on the preceding findings concerning probable cause and Officer Yribe's testimony it is hereby determined that Officer Yribe did not have reasonable cause to believe that Respondent was driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol.

IV

#### Lawful Arrest:

On 7/31/2016, at 1:16 PM Respondent was arrested for violation of Vehicle Code Section 23152, 23153, or 23140.

The determination that Respondent was arrested under the charge of driving under the influence, Vehicle Code Section 23152, 23153, or 23140 is based on:

<sup>o</sup> Explicit statements in DMV's documentary evidence.

As a result of the reasonable cause determination and the subsequent findings of an arrest taking place, it is hereby determined that Respondent was not lawfully arrested.

#### Chemical Test:

As based on the lack of sufficient evidence to rebut the chemical test results, it is hereby determined that Respondent submitted to and completed a chemical test of his blood; however, as a result, of the totality of evidence received the Department cannot support the administrative action against Respondent's driving privilege at this time.

#### Other Findings:

"Officer's testimony is deemed credible in that he demonstrated a clear contradiction of his report in comparison with Respondent's Exhibit "A" (MVARS), Officer contradicted the location reported first observed, the speed, the lane Respondent was located when first observed and that Respondent at no time was neither near or towards the center median divider; therefore, Officer's memory of the events was contradicted by his testimony provided after his review of the MVRS; therefore, supporting Counsel's contention as to no probable cause to have initiated a stop and supporting her motion to set aside.

VII

#### Driving With B.A.C. At Or Above 0.08%:

Based on the preceding it is determined that the preponderance of evidence in this case supports that Respondent was not driving a motor vehicle at the time that the concentration of alcohol in his blood was at or above 0.08%.

#### **DETERMINATION OF ISSUES**

- 1) The peace officer did not have reasonable cause to believe you were driving a motor vehicle in violation of Vehicle Code Section 23140, 23152, or 23153.
- 2) You were not placed under lawful arrest.
- 3) You were not driving a motor vehicle when you had .08% or more by weight of alcohol in your blood.




